Current position: Executive Director, European Research Group on Periodontology (ERGOPerio). Formerly, professor and Head, Department of Periodontology, School of Dental Medicine, University of Connecticut Health Science Centre. Professor and Head, Department of Periodontology at University College London – UK. Adjunct Professor, University of Berne – Switzerland, and University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill – USA. He serves as Editor in Chief of the Journal of Clinical Periodontology.

Clinical activity: a specialist in Periodontology maintains a part-time private practice limited to Periodontology and implant surgery with emphasis on regeneration, minimally invasive surgery and microsurgery. The focus of his recent research activities has been twofold: regeneration and bio-engineering of lost periodontal structures and incorporation of dental implants in the management of periodontal patients. The research of his team has spanned from fundamental discovery to clinical translation. He has been widely recognized for his contributions to improved periodontal diagnosis and risk assessment, control of periodontitis, the practice of periodontal regeneration and design and execution of large clinical trials in Periodontology and Implant Dentistry. He is considered as one of the most influential periodontists worldwide. He has been engaged worldwide in the planning and delivery of advanced educational programs in the fields of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry.

Dr. Pierpaolo Cortellini received his MD from the University of Florence and his speciality in dentistry from the University of Siena (Italy).

He runs a private practice in Florence (Italy), with services limited to periodontics. Dr. Cortellini is involved in clinical research in periodontology since 1982, with special emphasis to periodontal regeneration, aesthetics, and diagnosis.

Dr. Cortellini lectures extensively on a national and international level, and is the author of more than 100 original publications in scientific journals.

- incisions and sutures
- mucogingival surgery
- regenerative surgery

Hands-on

Exercise 1

- left mandibula ramus
- linear incision with a vertical interrupted circular suture

Exercise 2

- lingual ridge incision
- full thickness buccal and lingual flap
- transgingival implant 44
- connective tissue harvest, shaped for the edentulous saddle
- suture around implant and separating circular suture for flap replacement

Exercise 3

- lingual ridge incision
- full thickness buccal envelope flap
- palatal connective tissue graft harvest and placement
- suture of soft tissue graft placement
- modified internal mattress suture
- separate circular suture for flap placement
- continuous suture (chain, broken, simple) to close palatal incision

Exercise 4

- lingual ridge incision
- full thickness flap, buccal envelope flap
- submerged implant
- *Puros*[®] and barrier fixed with pins and implant healing screw
- modified internal mattress suture
- separate circular suture for flap replacement

Exercise 5

- root extraction 21
- socket membrane and *Puros*
- palatal epithelial-connective graft
- suture to place the graft

Exercise 6

- buccal and palatal flap: full thickness envelope flap
- root extraction 12
- immediate-load implant site 12
- *Puros* placement and buccal connective tissue graft

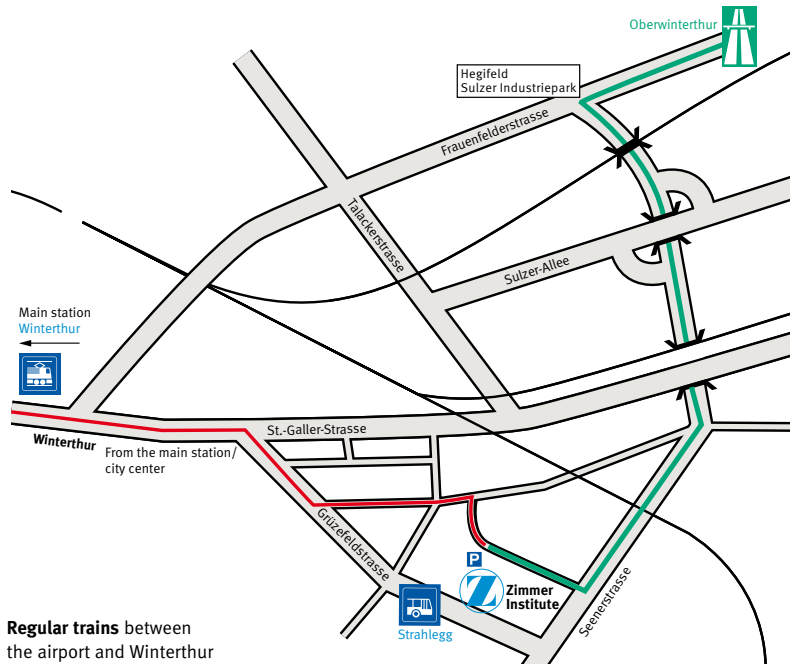
